Mayor Pigatt informed the residents that updates are forth coming.

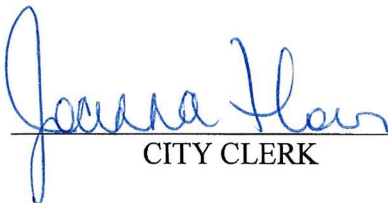
6. ADJOURNMENT:
